Tuesday, 25 January 2011

It was with great sadness that I learned of the appalling terrorist attack on Moscow's Domodedovo airport on Monday night.

My thoughts and prayers are with the Australian Russian community who are worrying about family and friends in Moscow at this difficult time.

Currently, 35 people have been confirmed dead and more than 120 are injured.
